The pilot flew an approach and landing at a private strip whichhad a grass surface and was approximately 605 metres in length;the landing was slightly long. The meteorological conditionswere good with no significant cloud, excellent visibility andcalm winds After landing, when the pilot applied the brakes,the aircraft veered left off the runway surface and into an area of longer, damp grass. The aircraft then ran into a hedge atapproximately 25 kt and flipped on to its back.
